Yesterday we celebrated the Feast of St Anthony, our Patron Saint

St. Anthony was born in Lisbon, Portugal in 1195, and baptised Ferdinand. Anthony originally entered the order of Augustinians, later joining the Franciscans in Italy. Anthony became a teacher of Franciscans and then a preacher in Italy, France and Belgium. He preached for a year and a half in Padua, a city in Italy, and died there. St. Anthony was held in high esteem for his preaching skills and for his love and devotion to Scripture. He is known as the Doctor of the Church and also the Patron of lost articles.






