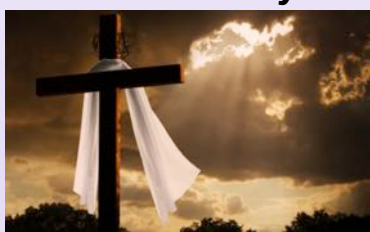

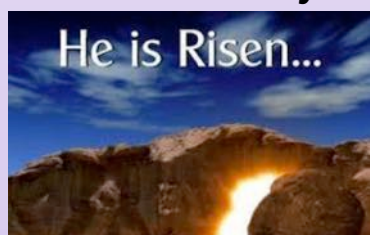

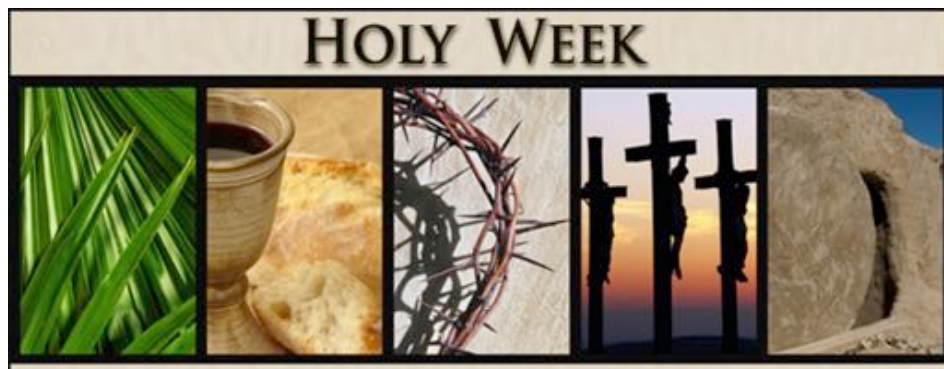

Dear families & friends of St Anthony's Catholic School,

How quickly this term has come to an end. We wish you all a happy and holy Easter and a safe and happy holiday, and we look forward to continuing to work together in term 2.



This week we are promoting cyber safety with all of our classes. You would have received a cyber safety letter on Friday of last week and it was also sent out on school stream. Ten parenting tips are attached to this newsletter. I strongly encourage you to carefully review the ways you are promoting cyber safety at your house. In our discussions at school this week, some students have revealed that they know of children who have received inappropriate messages on apps such as Live.ly, Music.ly and other live streaming apps. A live streaming app means that they are videoing live from their homes or other personal environments, and often watched by strangers as they answer personal questions from anonymous viewers. These apps are 12 + and are totally inappropriate for Primary school aged children.

Students have also shared with us that they feel concerned about letting their parents know if they see something inappropriate, as they are worried they will get into trouble. Our message is Always tell a trusted adult (who may initially be a little shocked), but will help you keep safe. Please open up these sorts of conversations

How to get the school stream app on your mobile device

iPhone / iPad iOS 7.x - 9.x

1. From your mobile device go to the **App Store** search for **School Stream**
2. Tap the **FREE/GET** button to the right of the School Stream listing
3. Tap the **INSTALL** button
4. Enter your Apple ID and password & tap **OK**
5. Wait for the install icon to change to **OPEN**
6. Tap the **OPEN** button
7. You will be prompted to accept push notifications, you will need to select **OK**
8. Start typing **your school name** into the search then **SELECT your school**

Android / Tablet

1. From your mobile device go to the **Play Store** search for **School Stream**
2. Tap the School Stream listing
3. Tap the **INSTALL** button
4. Tap the **ACCEPT** button
5. Wait for the app to install then tap the **OPEN** button
6. Start typing **your school name** into the search then **SELECT your school**
7. Tap the **DONE** button in the top left
